Impact100 East Bay will award that three grants totaling \$146,000 in 2023 to non-profits in Alameda and Contra Costa Counties. Thanks to our 126 members and a very generous one time donation, grants available are: \$100,000 Impact Grant, \$26,000 Community Grant and a special \$20,000 Community Grant. Forty-Six local non-profits submitted proposals for these Grants ahead of our March 3, 2023 deadline!

Our mission is to unite women in Alameda and Contra Costa counties through collective philanthropy. We aim to make a significant difference in the lives of those in need by supporting deserving local nonprofit organizations that serve them. Each member donates \$1,000 annually to collectively fund nonprofit grants. For 2023 126 members equals \$126,000 in member funded grants!

Since 2017, Impact100 East Bay has awarded \$660,00 to nine non-profits in our community. Details of these grant awards can be found [here](#). Our Grants Committee started work on selection of this year's nonprofit finalists. The Grants are awarded based on Member vote in September 2023.

She provided key insights to our members about philanthropic women, and especially collective giving which is the foundation of Impact100.
